



Kathe Jarka is an Alexander Teacher and a professional cellist, having graduated from ACAT and the Juilliard School.

As an Alexander teacher she has a large private practice in New York City, with an emphasis on performing arts, is an associate teacher at ATNYC, and is a member of the Alexander Technique faculty at the Aspen Music School. She has done extensive post-graduate study with John Nicholls and Pedro de Alcantara, and has presented workshops in Norway, Mexico and at numerous schools, including the Mannes College of Music, New York University, Yale University, The Hartt School, The School for Strings, and the New York Youth Symphony among others.

As a cellist Kathe has performed in 25 states, and in Europe and Asia. A scholarship student of the late Leonard Rose she has participated in the Marlboro, Tanglewood and Yale-at-Norfolk music festivals, among others. She has collaborated with such artists as Yo Yo Ma, Gil Shaham and the Juilliard Quartet. She continues to perform, and is on the faculties of the Juilliard School and The Mannes College of Music where she teaches young cellists.
